innovate with the most efficient parking
solution on the market.**

Paris, September 19, 2017: OPnGO and Polly announce their partnership to create a new experience of parking for the motorist coupling off-street and roadside parking.

This solution is already **available in Paris, Metz and soon in Issy-les-Moulineaux.**

While 20% of the traffic in large cities is generated by drivers looking for a parking space, the solution available to the users makes it possible to **no longer turn randomly to look for a parking space and to save time and money.**

Together, OPnGO and Polly are able to offer the motorist a whole new way to park everywhere, **faster, cheaper and effortlessly.**

By downloading the Polly app and creating their OPnGO account, drivers will find:

1. The right recommendation **for parking on the street or in a parking lot** around the destination, in real-time and according to the chosen criteria (price or distance).
2. A tailor-made itinerary: from their current position to their place of parking, maximizing the chances of finding their space as quickly as possible by taking into account the availability of spaces and traffic, with integrated navigation;
3. The possibility **to book in advance** a space in a suggested car park for a defined period and **to benefit from a discount of up to 50%.**
4. Optimized access to more than 200,000 parking spaces thanks to OPnGO technology: the driver no longer takes a ticket, the barrier opens up by reading a license plate or accessing a smartphone;
5. The possibility **to pay for parking** in the street and in the car parks in the application (mobile payment of roadside parking is currently available only in Metz).

This solution will be deployed in hundreds of cities in Europe and around the world. Polly and OPnGO applications are available for free on iOS and Android.

The international partnership of two promising start-ups in the service of mobility

OPnGO, a French start-up present in more than 70 cities in France, Spain, Belgium and Luxembourg, offers drivers easy and dematerialized access to more than 200,000 parking spaces in about 400 car parks as well as mobile payment of roadside parking in the streets of 8 cities in France and Luxembourg. Launched in June 2016, OPnGO has tens of thousands of clients. It has privileged partnerships with Indigo, the world's leading parking company, Gecina, France's leading office operator, AccorHotels, the European hospitality leader.

Polly, the innovative solution developed by the Israeli start-up sPARK, originally launched in Tel Aviv and Jerusalem, was first offered to Parisians in 2016. Polly is an application that halves the search time of parking for the motorist. It allows him to follow the best route and choose from the best parking options. Polly helps motorists to park in Paris with confidence.

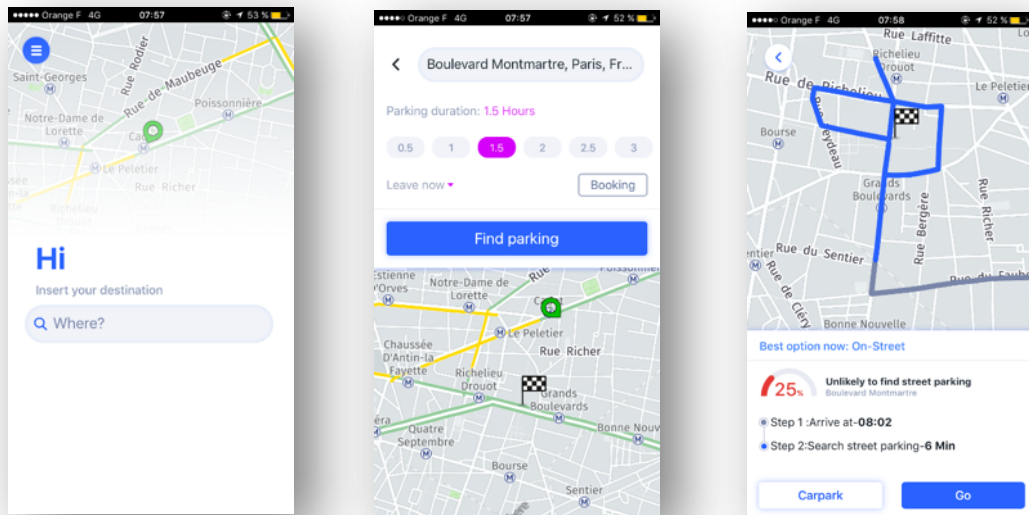

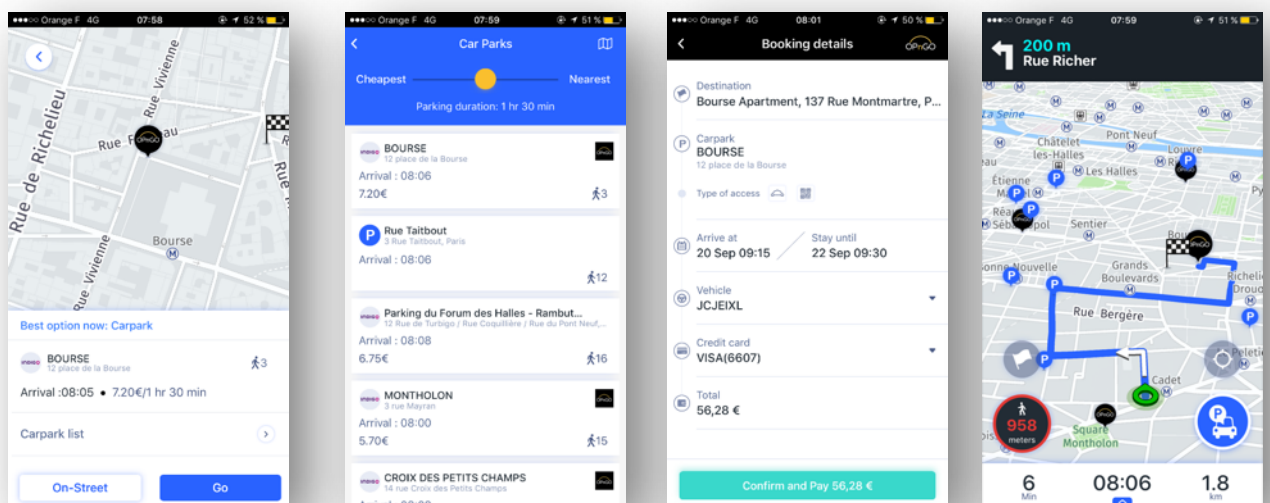
